# PCPC PRAYER GUIDE INTRODUCTION

This guide has a simple aim: to help us grow in our love for God through time in His Word and prayer. The Bible teaches that in order to love God, we need a relationship with Him. That relationship has been provided by God Himself, through overcoming the alienation caused by our sin through the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus Christ, God the Son. In union with Christ, we now have intimate access to God as our heavenly Father. Scripture and prayer are the means through which we experience, apply, and enjoy that relationship. As we learn to pray, and as we learn to listen and obey the gracious overtures of God's Word, we learn to live as God's children – to love and trust Him more fully.

## WHY DAILY PRAYER?

Why set aside fixed times every day for prayer? Why not simply pray unprompted, when the stirring comes? Practically speaking, we are creatures attuned to rhythms. We order our lives by sunrises and sunsets, by hours, weeks, seasons, and years. Daily prayer is a way of consecrating our ordinary rhythms to God, ensuring that all of life is offered to Him. C. S. Lewis once wrote, "Relying on God has to begin all over again every day as if nothing had yet been done." And so it must. Our relationship with God should take hold of our schedules as well as our hearts.

Historically, this has been the way of God's people. Consider the testimonies of the psalmists:

"Blessed is the man whose delight is in the law of the Lord, and on His law he meditates *day and night*." (Psalm 1:1-2)

"*Evening and morning and at noon* I cry out to you..." (Psalm 55:17)

"*Seven times* a day do I praise you..." (Psalm 119:64)

By the time of the first century, the ritual of daily prayer was formally embedded in Jewish spirituality. There were several hours in the day that marked regular times for prayer. The first detailed miracle in Acts happened because Peter and John were going to the temple "at the hour of prayer, the ninth hour" (Acts 3:1) for three o'clock prayers. Peter's vision in Acts 10 confirming God's grace for the Gentiles occurred as he was observing sixth-hour prayer, his noon devotions (Acts 10:9). The community that gathered after Pentecost devoted themselves daily to "the apostles teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers" (Acts 2:42).

The practice of daily prayer continued through the early church and expanded consistently throughout time and culture wherever the gospel spread. Along

with Sunday worship and the sacraments, daily prayer remains a central way that Christians all over the world express devotion to Christ.

But we might simply hearken back to Jesus Himself. Jesus set aside times to pray regularly even as the eternal Son of God. He celebrated His dependence on the Father (John 5:19, 30), and sought sanctuary in solitude with Him (Luke 5:16). If it was necessary for Jesus, who is "very God of very God," how much more for us, who are made to bear His image.

## WHY A PRAYER GUIDE?

A common objection to using a liturgy for devotions is that it restricts freedom, deteriorating into heartless formality. However, if you've ever found yourself repeating the same words and phrases over and over again in prayer "spontaneously," then you know that our own minds and experiences are just as restrictive. Guided prayer is not meant to curb freedom but to bolster it, by introducing into our prayer life the language and imagery of the Scriptures.

Here are a few compelling reasons to use a prayer guide:

### 1. It helps us to pray regularly.

Many people do not pray regularly because they do not know where to begin. A prayer guide takes the pressure off needing to make that decision anew every day. It repeatedly says, "Start here." You do not need a stirring, a reason, a plan, or consistency. Simply, "start here", and let God's Word lead you into prayer.

### 2. It helps us to pray biblically.

In this prayer guide, there is no commentary from gifted Christian authors or pastors. It is uncluttered, so to speak. The elements come either directly from Scripture or from common worship. The majority of time is spent in the Psalms, a book of the Bible meant especially for prayer and worship. One of the encouraging messages reiterated in the Psalms is that you do not have to put on a happy face to live the Christian life. Praying biblically allows us to pray the truth of who we are while growing in the hope of who we might yet become.

### 3. It helps us to pray communally.

Though we are praying individually, we are doing so together, specifically as a church body. This book is meant for this flock, in this time and place. To know that others with whom God has joined us are reading and praying the same words encourages us in our common journey. Prayer is a communal work as much as an individual one.

## HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE?

Use this guide however it is helpful to you. For many, that means using it just as it is. For others who are already committed to daily reading plans or Bible studies, that may mean skipping the Scripture readings and only using some of the other portions. For those who are in the habit of family worship, you can adapt the guide to read and pray together as a family.

Here are suggestions for each of the elements:

### The Call to Worship

The Call to Worship is God initiating with you through His Word. Read the call, perhaps out loud. Receive God's invitation to worship Him as spoken to you in that moment.

### The Prayers of Praise and Thanksgiving

Praise God for who He is as He has shown in His Word and in your life. Thank Him for His presence and gifts in your life.

### The Readings

The Psalms follow the readings from the Book of Common Prayer, which covers all the Psalms every 30 days. Get to know the words here and you will better know Jesus Himself. There is no book of the Bible Jesus quoted more often than the Psalms.

The other daily readings for this season are from Luke's Gospel, the Gospel most associated with Jesus' universal kingship. We begin where Luke begins, and continue into the section in which Jesus sets His face toward Jerusalem, preparing us for the coming seasons of Lent and Easter.

### The Prayers for the Day and Prayers for the Night

In the morning, begin by saying The Lord's Prayer, the model for prayer that Jesus taught His disciples. If you do not know it, you can find the words in the Appendix in this guide. Each phrase of the Lord's Prayer is filled with grace and challenge. Say the prayer expectantly for the day ahead.

Prayers of Supplication and Intercession are opportunities for you to lay out before God whatever burdens you carry, as well as the burdens carried by others. Ask Him for things. Ask Him for mercy. Ask Him to help you become more like Christ.

The Closing Prayer is a way to conclude. All of the closing prayers draw from the Book of Common Prayer, and are unique to either morning or evening. They are called, "collects," because they gather our prayers together and present them before God collectively, as we go about our scattered lives. Pray this prayer as your own, in the confidence that others are praying with you.

## **The Confession of Sin**

The Confession of Sin occurs at night, as we review our days. It is an opportunity to repent for the ways we have missed the mark, and to receive the grace we need for renewal and change. In the Appendix, you will find a longer explanation for the process of self-examination that fits here.

## **The Words of Assurance**

The Words of Assurance are God's promise to forgive, cleanse, accept, and renew you in Christ. Hold onto these as you would anything of great value. Return to them when doubts or disillusionment grow.

## **The Grace**

The Grace is God's blessing on you as you go out into your day or lay your head down to sleep. Receive it as a final word until you return to pray again.

## **Sundays**

Sundays are unique, it is our time to gather and worship as a church family, to celebrate once again the victory of Christ over sin and death. There are only Psalm readings on Sunday because the liturgy of corporate worship is our primary focus. Consider using the Sunday morning liturgy again at night for personal prayer.

## **A Note for Families**

My family uses this guide for our times of family worship at night. We have found it most helpful to take turns as the reader, as one person reads our call to worship, another the confession of sin, another the words of assurance, and so on. This keeps everyone involved in speaking the Word of God to one another. During the prayers of praise and thanksgiving and the prayers of supplication and intercession, we each say something aloud, no matter how short or clumsy (we are all learners!). During the personal examination and confession, we take a minute to pray to God personally in the quietness of our own thoughts. This is just one way to use the guide as a family. I encourage you to explore how it might best help your own worship and devotion as a family.

As a final word, there are many great reading plans, devotionals, and exercises to encourage in us a life of prayer. This is a way to pray, only one among many that has grown up in the history of God's people. Most important is not the method, but the reality of loving and trusting God. May your relationship with Him grow.

# WELCOME TO THE SEASON OF EASTER.

Easter is traditionally the climax of all the Christian feasts and it's easy to see why. Easter celebrates the final victory of God in Jesus Christ, through His bodily resurrection from the dead. Without Easter, as the Apostle Paul writes to the early church in Corinth, everything we believe about Jesus and His kingdom is meaningless. Without Easter, the life of Jesus is merely the story of another good man trying to change the world. Without Easter, the cross is the failure of Jesus' massive ambitions, and His foolish misread on the political powers of His day. Without Easter, the tomb is emblematic of the destiny that awaits us all, no matter what we do.

But Easter transforms all of that. With Easter, the life of Jesus is the story of the man who does in fact change the world. With Easter, the cross is the success of His work, the unstoppable pattern of God's love in a broken world, and the ransom of our lives from the horror of sin. With Easter, the tomb is a necessary confrontation with and triumph over the vanity and sadness of death. With Easter, the old order of things is overturned and the first day of the new creation dawns. Easter is the climactic Christian feast because in the resurrection of Christ God has begun to fulfill His promise to make all things new: our suffering, our work, our time, our relationships, our culture, our bodies - the entire world!

How then should we celebrate such incredulous grace? In a very real sense, we celebrate Easter every Sunday by gathering together as Jesus' people for worship. Christians have always worshipped on Sundays because it's a celebration not merely of a new week but of a new world, and thus a foretaste of the eternal joy and rest we have in Jesus Christ.

But Easter Sunday and the season that follows (50 days, until Pentecost) can be a time for even more focused celebration. If we've observed Lent by fasting from something we normally enjoy, we might celebrate Easter by feasting on that thing as a good gift provided by the grace of God. If Lent has been a time of deep introspection and repentance, then we might turn our attention now to the joy of our new identity in Christ - that we are no longer the sum of our sin and shame, but forever the beloved children of God and co-heirs with Christ. Another tradition that has partially endured since early times is the tradition of wearing new, white clothes on Easter Sunday. Originally, only the newly baptized wore white garments of new linen. But that continued to expand to all believers so that new clothes symbolized the new life for all who trusted in Christ.

Perhaps, however, we should look to the first Christians as models of how to celebrate the resurrection of Christ. What did the early followers of Jesus do when they were confronted with the truth of Easter? They joyfully shared that

news with others. As Peter testifies in Acts, they could not "help speaking about what they had seen or heard." Easter is a good season to renew our commitment to share the Gospel of Jesus Christ personally with others. And it's a reminder that evangelism is no dull obligation. Rather, it is the explosion of joy found at the proclamation that the tomb is empty, and Jesus is alive.

How might you renew your own commitment to share the good news of Easter with others? Here are just a few things to consider during this season:

- Spend time revisiting your own personal story of rescue and consider writing it out. When did the joy of Easter sink into your own heart? What people did God use in your life? How were you persuaded of the truth and beauty of Christ? What circumstances were meaningful along the way?
- Make a list of people to pray for whom you want to respond to the gospel. Commit to praying for them and asking God for opportunities to share with them.
- Write an account of how God has been at work in your life in the past six months. Ask God to make you sensitive and open to an opportunity to share your experience with a seeking friend.

May this Easter season give you renewed joy in God's immense love for you.

Receive the words of assurance for the day, leaning on the promises and mercy of God.

Conclude in prayer, offering yourself body and soul, in your thoughts, words, and actions, as a living sacrifice to God, which is your spiritual worship.
